

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Can I propose an area of work that has not been listed as an example?**

Yes, the list provided under each strategic area are examples that we are interested in supporting. However, you may propose a new theme that falls into any of the 9 strategic categories provided.

- **When will I know whether my application has been successful or not?**

We aim to respond each applicant and communicate results of the selection process by May 21st, 2021.

- **Will I be able to request a no cost extension beyond December 2021?**

Unfortunately, we will not be able to extend the grant beyond December 2021.

- **The grant implementation period may not be sufficient to fully achieve a policy/advocacy objective. Can I still apply?**

We are aware that achieving advocacy objectives in short periods of time depends on the socio-political context and your area of work. We encourage civil society organisations to propose activities that are part of long-time processes, for which we may not see tangible achievements by the end of the grant.

- **What will Frontline AIDS value when reviewing the applications?**

When evaluating the applications, the team will highly value that applicants can show unique capabilities / proven expertise in the proposed area of work, demonstrate a clear sense of its advocacy targets and strategy and that they identify specific deliverables and a clear timeline for these.

- **Will I need to provide any organisational documentation if I am successful?**

Yes, successful applicants will need to comply with Frontline AIDS due diligence processes. This includes providing some organisational documentation. If you have any question or concern, please reach out to screspo@contractor.frontlineaids.org

- **Am I eligible to this funding if I already receive funds from other advocacy / influence funding mechanisms?**

Whereas receiving funds from other funding mechanisms does not disqualify your application, we will take into consideration how your proposal aligns with any of the activities you may be already working on.
